Our vineyard responded partners masterfully, adjusting canopy management to protect our fruit. Perfect fall conditions allowed for ideal ripening. The wines show beautiful concentration with perfectly developed flavors.

TASTING NOTES

From the historic 1972 plantings at Bacchus Vineyard, now part of the newly established White Bluffs AVA, this elegant Cabernet showcases the remarkable resilience of 50-year-old vines. Despite 2021's intense heat dome, these deep-rooted veterans delivered stunning fruit. Layers of raspberry and mountain huckleberry weave with sagebrush and cardamom, touched by cocoa-dipped red fruits and subtle toasted bread notes. The exceptionally creamy entry builds to a spherical, polished palate, This graceful expression promises a decade-plus of evolution in bottle.
