### 2025 COLUMBIA VALLEY ROSÉ



#### VINTAGE NOTES

2025 delivered our best yields in five years with incredibly high fruit quality. The 2025 season proved near-perfect: mild winter, ideal spring budbreak, and excellent late-May bloom set healthy fruit-to-canopy balance. May 21st marked the end of significant rain until October, finishing over three inches below average and requiring vigilant irrigation management at our historically dry-farmed Cut Bank Estate. Average summer temperatures and warmer fall brought rapid harvest starting August 27th.

#### TASTING NOTES

Sourced from Seven Hills Vineyard and Weinbau Vineyard, this Columbia Valley Rosé is everything we expect our "Pink Stuff" to be. Increased production aims to satiate demand after last year's quick sellout, though this rosé is built to be here for a good time, not for a long time. The wine pours a pretty pink color, slightly darker than previous vintages, with aromas of chilled strawberries, white peach, and orange peel, evolving to reveal tree-ripened apricot, elusive florals, and an underlying herbaceous note reminiscent of Mediterranean spice. The palate enters with an almost-sweet creaminess balanced by smooth acidity and structure: tart pie cherries meet grapefruit and gooseberry. Hard to put down—get it while you can.
